

Rifleman's Fall Classic

Dates: Nov 4 & 5, 2017

Location: Central Carolina Gun Club, 5167 N Carolina 62, Burlington, NC

Range: Range #4 – 200 yd Walkdown

Sanctioned by: Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP)

Rules: Current CMP Vintage Military Rules Apply

Eligibility: Match is open to the public so you do not need to be a CCGCI member to participate

Classification: None.

Fees: \$30 adult, \$15 youth (<21) per day, \$45 adult, \$25 youth (<21) for both days

Rifles Permitted: Match 1 : John C. Garand/Springfield Rifle/Military Vintage Bolt Rifles. (CMP Sanctioned) Allowed rifles include as-issue M1 Garand, 1903 /1903A3 Springfield, M1917 Enfield, 1941 Johnsons, and U.S. Krag Rifles, and all foreign military Bolt Rifles. **Match 2:** Unlimited Garand allows modified versions of these same rifles per CMP rules for an Unlimited Garand Match. **Match 3:** This is an "out-of-competition" match for M1 Carbines and other non-scoped WWII era rifles not allowed in matches 1 or 2. Accuracy modifications are allowed..

Ammunition: Furnished by the competitor (minimum 50 rounds).

Targets: SR

Squadding: Squadding will be done during registration just prior to the match.

Scoring: All competitors will be required to score and service targets for other relays. (walk down targets)

Match Schedule:

Registration: 8:00 to 8:30.

First shot downrange at 9:00 am.

All firing is at 200 yards on the SR highpower rifle target.

Sighters – Max of 5 sighting or practice shots, time limit of 5 minutes.

Stage 1 - Slow fire, prone 20 record shots, time limit of 20 minutes.

Stage 2 - Rapid fire, prone from standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 70 seconds.

Stage 3 - Rapid fire, sitting or kneeling from standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 60 seconds

Stage 4 - Slow fire, standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 10 minutes.

Awards: Bragging rights mostly. There will be some small cash awards for Stage and Agg winners.

Bring your own refreshments. Weather permitting, we will grill something in the pits after the match.
