Warmer weather also means the range will see more traffic. Please remember to pick up your trash, targets and casings before you leave. Everyone should be able to enjoy a clean range.

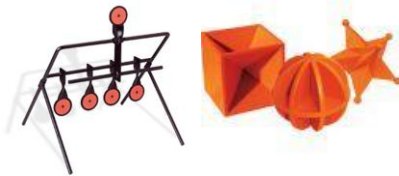
Thanks for you help!

The 3 Golden Safety Rules:

1. ALWAYS keep the gun pointed in a safe direction.
2. ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot.
3. ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use.

The following type of "shooting targets" are not allowed on the range.



Air Soft and Tumbling targets are not allowed on the range at any time. Please read through the range rules pertaining to allowed targets.
